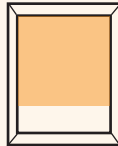




# HOW TO MEASURE FOR BLINDS

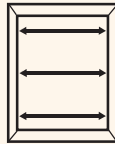
## Inside

- Mounted in the window frame
- Clean uncluttered look



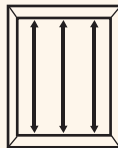
## Step 1

- Measure the inside **width** at 3 places: top, middle, and bottom.
- Round **down** to the nearest 1/8".
- Write down the **smallest** measurement. This is the ordering width.



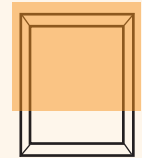
## Step 2

- Measure the inside **height** at 3 places: left, middle and right.
- Round **up** to the nearest 1/8".
- Write down the **longest** measurement. This is your ordering height.



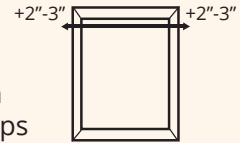
## Outside

- Mounted to the wall, ceiling or molding around the window
- Hides unattractive windows



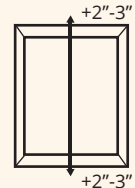
## Step 1

- Measure the **width** at the top of the window.
- **Add 4" to 6"** (up to 3" for each side) to help eliminate light gaps and ensure privacy.
- Write down the **total** measurement. This is your ordering width.



## Step 2

- Measure the **height** of the window.
- **Add 4" to 6"** (up to 3" for the top and bottom) to help eliminate light gaps and ensure privacy.
- Write down the **total** measurement. This is your ordering height.



If Chadwell Supply is cutting your blinds, provide measurements of final sizes needed; we will ensure your blinds and mounting hardware will fit and operate perfectly. Note: The width of the finished blinds or shades will always be a bit narrower than the width specified on the order.
